### WHEREAS:

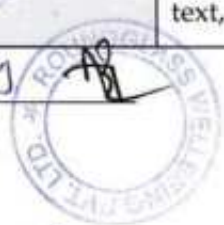

3.	Responsibility of AEF	AEF shall be responsible for the following during the Term hereof: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Appoint a single point of contact and ensure compliance of the program schedule.</li><li>2. <u>Collaboration with the single point of contact for the group, for conducting online &amp; offline activities related to the Program for students;</u></li><li>3. Ensure selected students' participation as mental health ambassadors (peer mentors);</li><li>4. Provide information as requested from time to time of all students for <b>RoundGlass Wellbeing Private Limited</b> applications.</li><li>5. Grant permission to conduct mental wellbeing-related campaigns &amp; workshops on campus;</li></ol>



8.	Termination	Either party may terminate this MoU at any time during the Term by giving a 15 (fifteen) days written notice to the other Party.
9.	Dispute Resolution	In the event of any dispute or differences arising at any time between the Parties hereto as to the construction, meaning or effect of this Agreement or any clause or thing contained herein or the rights, duties, liabilities and obligations of the Parties hereto or breach thereof, the parties shall in good faith endeavor to resolve the dispute by mutual discussion. In the event, the parties are unable to do so, the matter will be settled by arbitration subject to the provision of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and as amended from time to time. The Parties agree and shall mutually endeavor to appoint a single arbitrator from AEF , within a period of thirty (30) days. The appointed arbitrator will be referred for resolution. The arbitration proceedings will held at Nashik and only Nashik court will have Jurisdiction to resolve the matter.
10.	Governing Law	The laws of the Republic of India shall govern the validity, construction, interpretation and effect of this MoU without regard to the conflict of laws principles and any dispute in relation to this MoU shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts at Nasik.
11.	Confidentiality	The Parties hereby agree to not disclose the content of this MoU to any third party. Rights to the Confidentiality are a right "in rem" against all recipients of any such Confidential Information or other information, whether intended or not.
