#### Abstract

Data is a crucial input for social scientists, governments, policymakers, etc., enabling a better understanding of social complexities and the development and implementation of empirically-based policies and interventions to address problems and enhance society. However, numerous libraries are not actively engaged in open data-related activities and services due to various reasons.
