## **Scholarship Policy**

## Preamble-

Each year we should award scholarships, may be in the form of fee remission, to outstanding and needy students. These scholarships are given as fixed amount as Rs. 10K, 7.5K and 5K. Three scholarships to each year of each course will be distributed. The students are selected on the basis of family economical background, exceptional academic, and overall all-round performance (sports, cultural, social and any other justifiable).

## Objectives:

- 1. To help meritorious students who are economically weak by offering financial assistance, this in longer run can help in making Brand of Ashoka.
- 2. To attract meritorious students who are financially weak to take admission in Ashoka.

#### Eligibility:

- 1. The Annual income of the parents should not exceed Rs 5,00,000
- 2. More that 75% in all examinations as below

- 3. Overall performance as given in the policy below.
- 4. The students should be the regular student of ACBCS.

#### **Documents required:**

- 1. Bio Data specifying academic and overall performance in a glance which will specify annual income of parents also.
- 2. Income certificate of parents.
- 3. All applicable mark sheet photocopies
- 4. Certificates all-round performances. (sports, cultural, social and any other justifiable).
- 5. Recommendation from Coordinator for regularity and sincerity of the student.

### **Selection Procedure:**

- 1. The eligible student will submit application to Admin Officer to avail scholarship and will attach all necessary documents.
- 2. Admin officer will make the summery sheet.
- 3. The principal with consultation of respective class teachers/co-ordinators and mentors will scrutinise the list.
- 4. Interview of Scrutinised candidates will be conducted by Expert Panel. Expert Panel will be comprising of
  - a. Director, HE, AEF (Chairman)
  - b. Administrator, HE, AEF
  - c. HoD, Accounts
  - d. Principal.
- 5. The panel will finalise three ranks from each year of each course (total 12 students)
