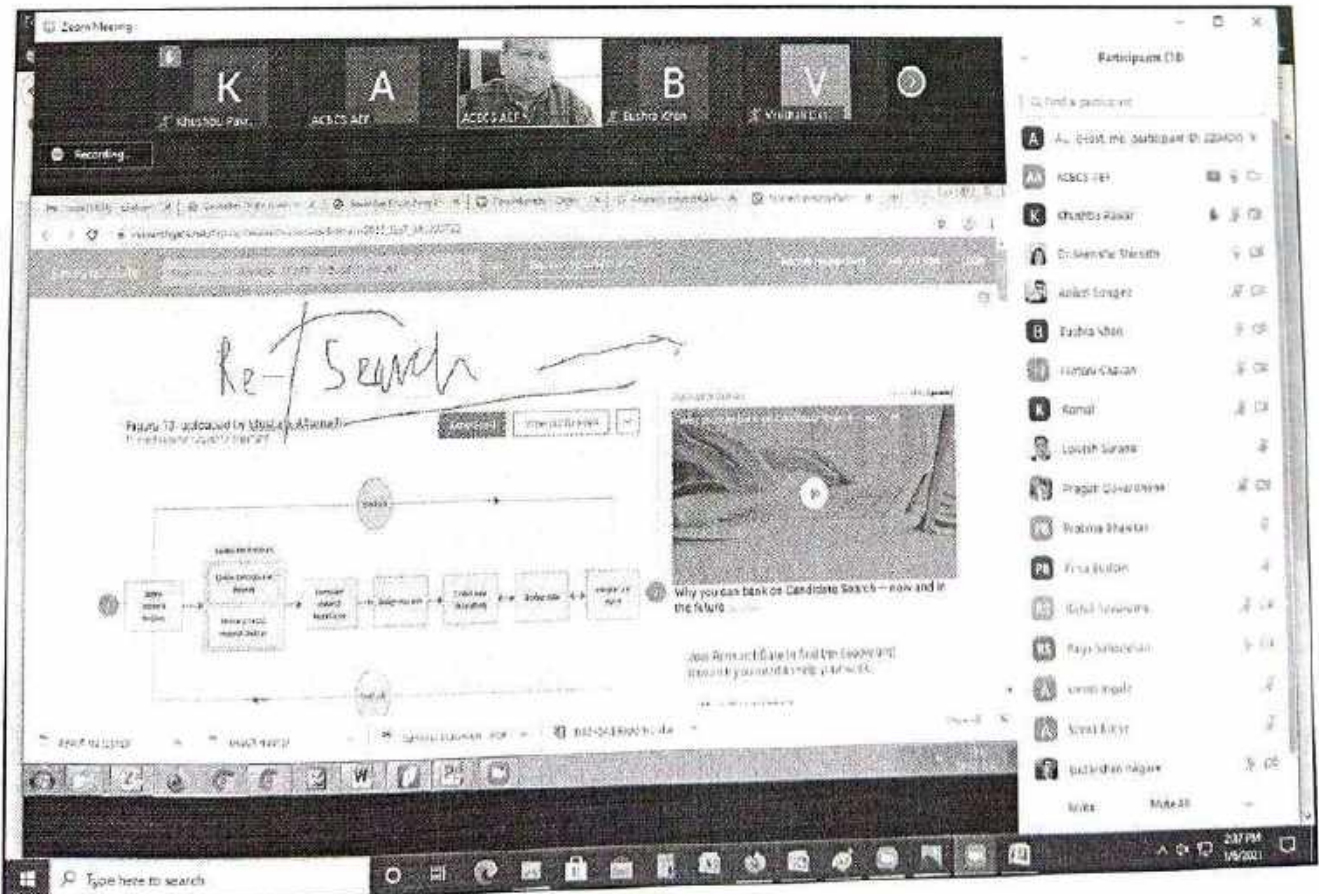

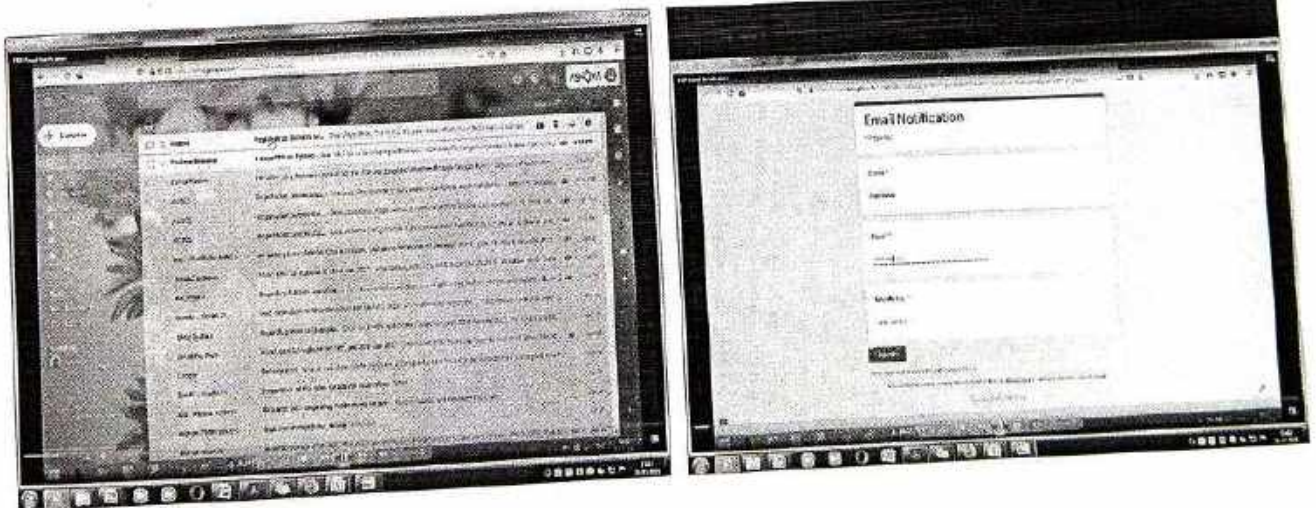

Objectives:

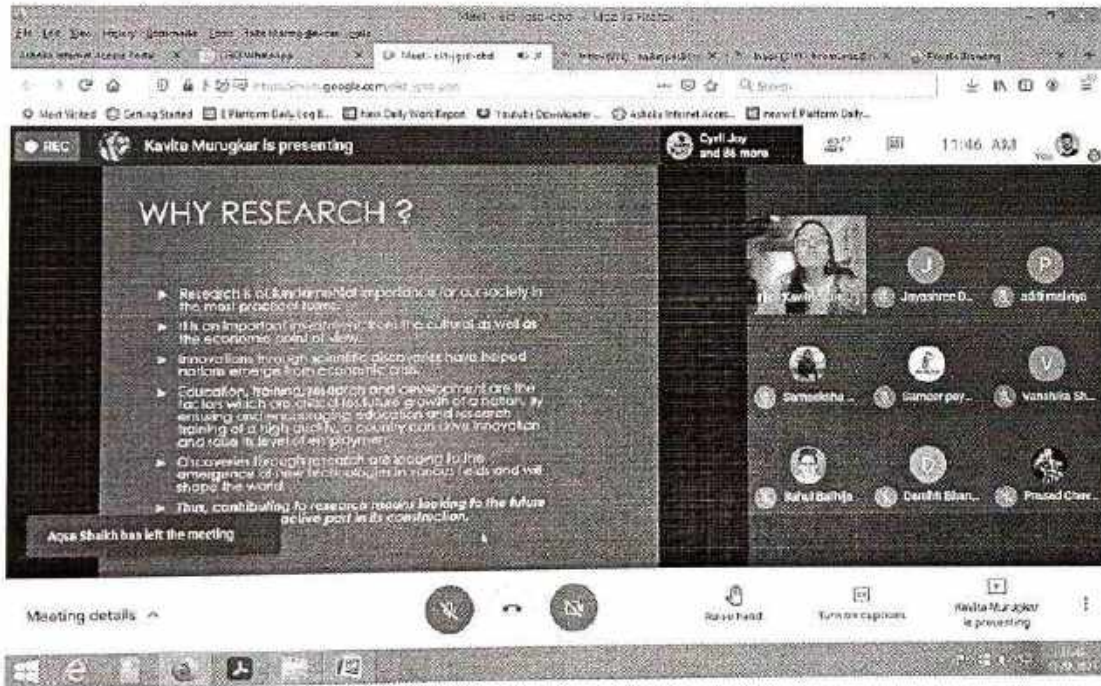
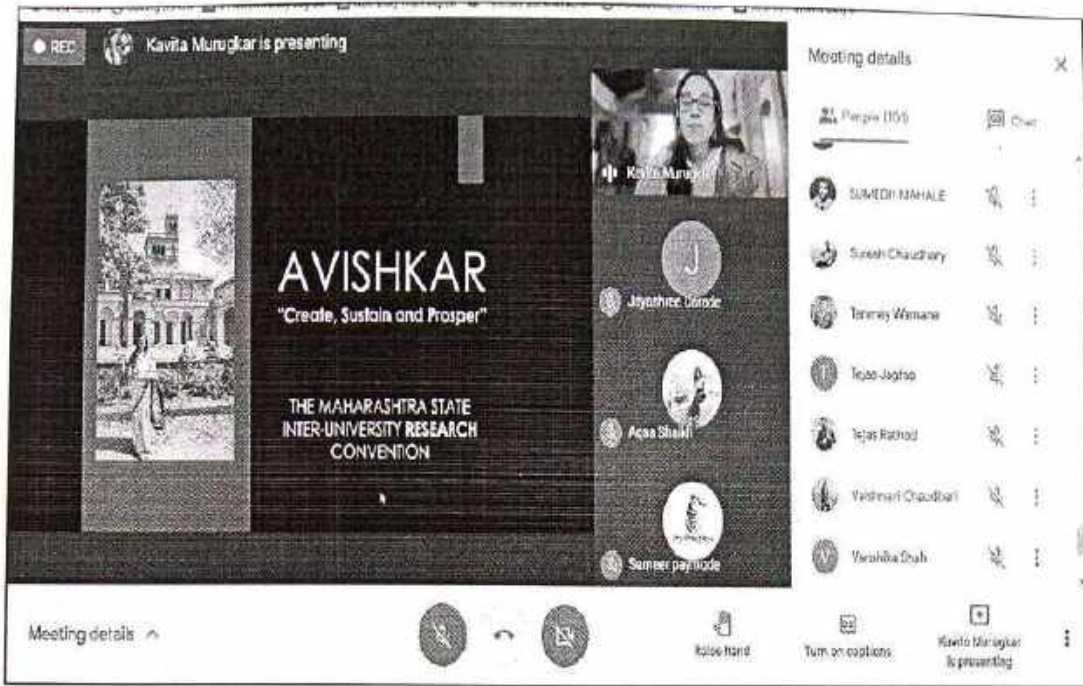

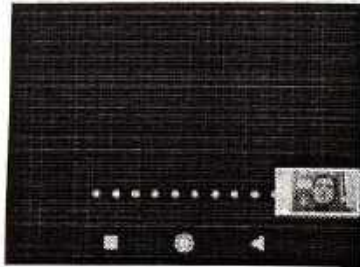
