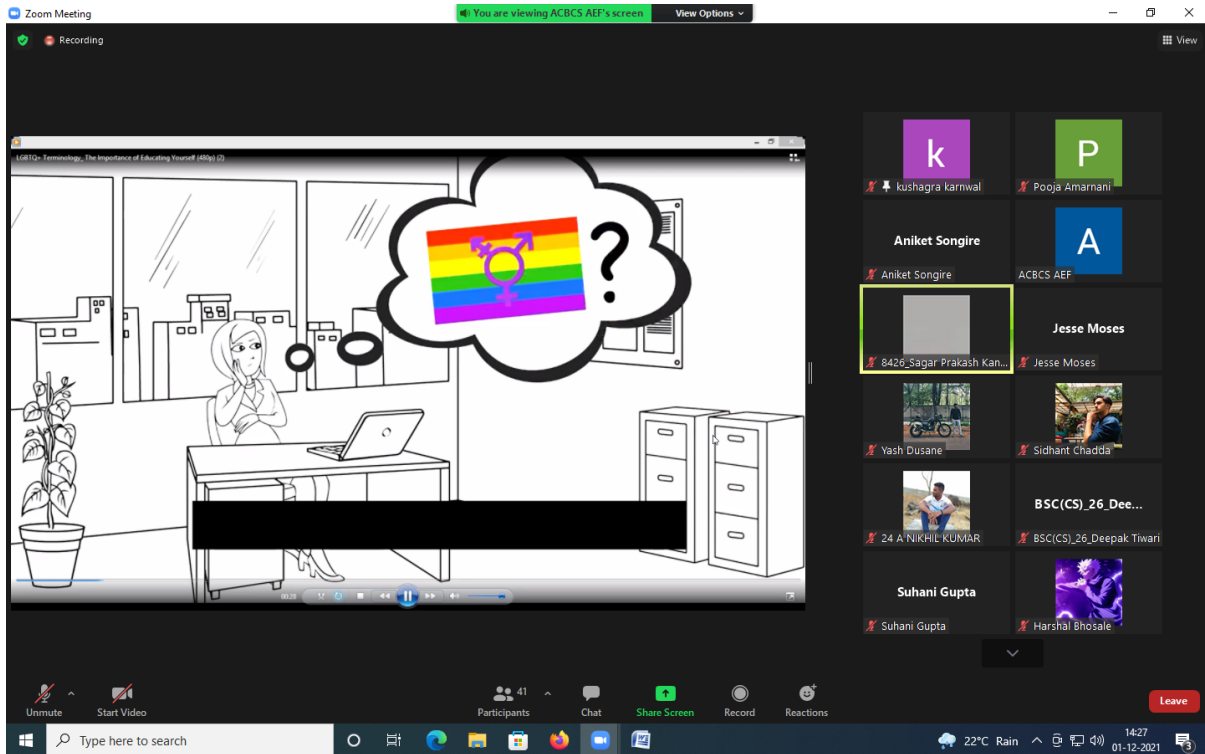
AIDS is the final stage of the disease caused by infection with a type of virus called HIV.

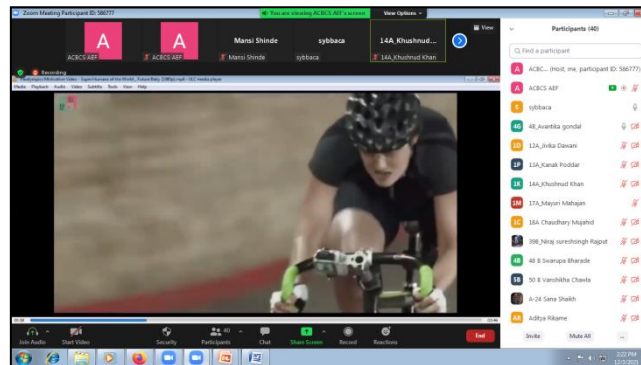
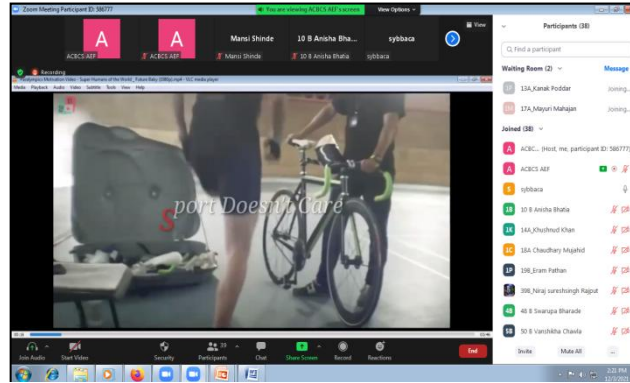

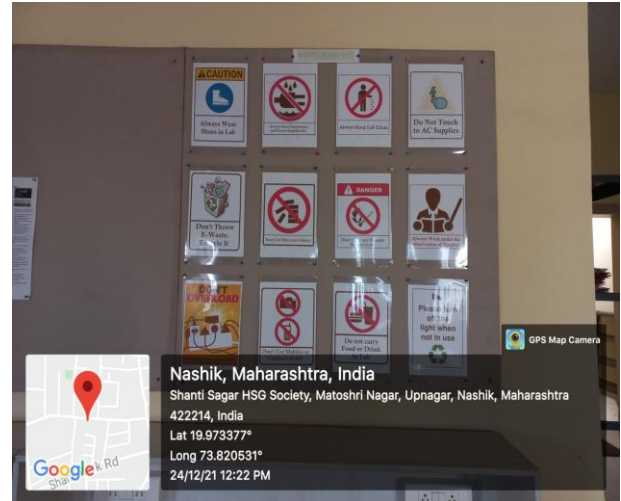
