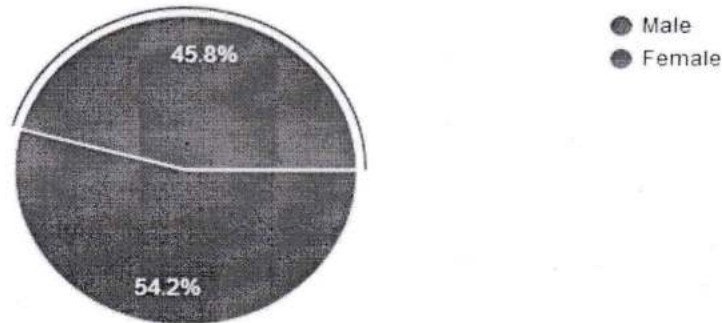


## Student satisfaction Survey Report Academic Year 2023-24

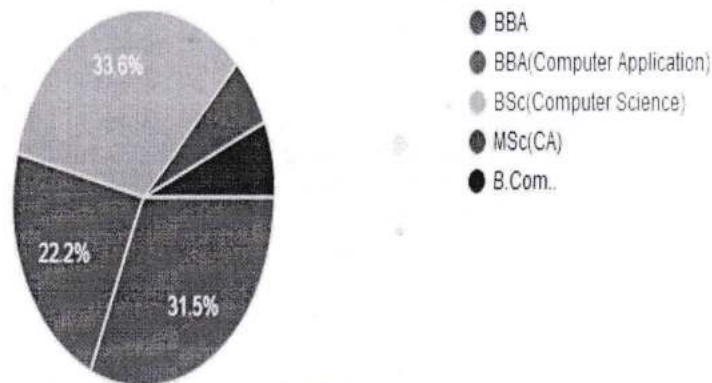

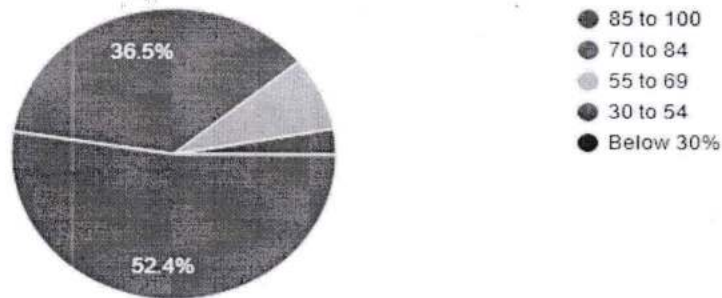
### Course wise contribution of Students;

How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

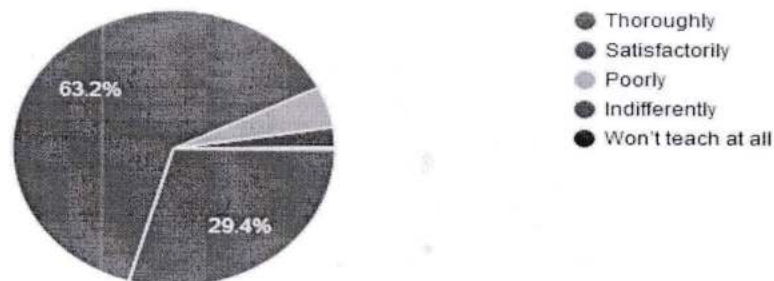

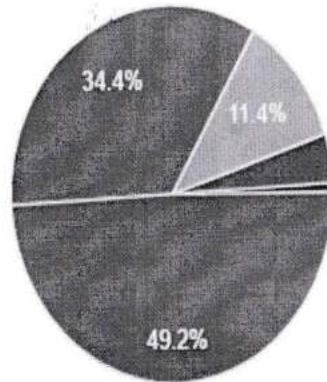
How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

### How well were the teachers able to communicate?

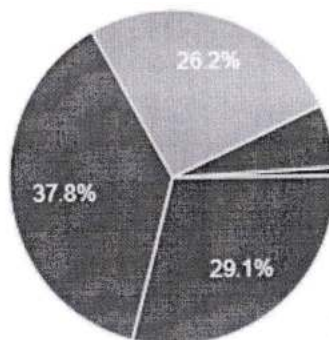

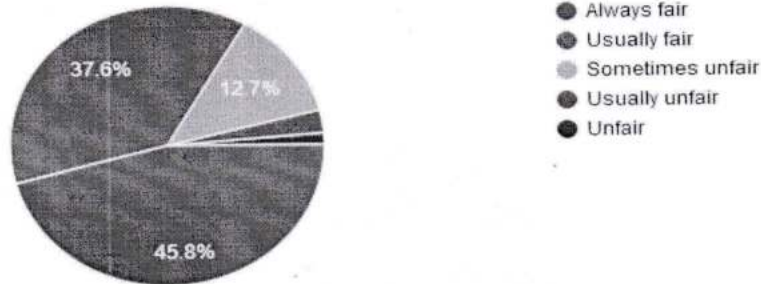

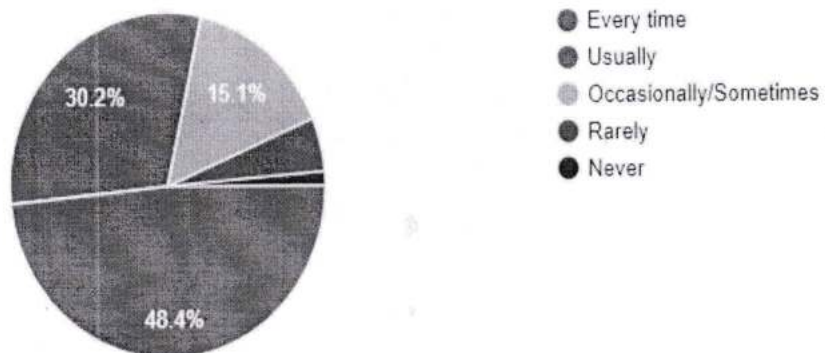

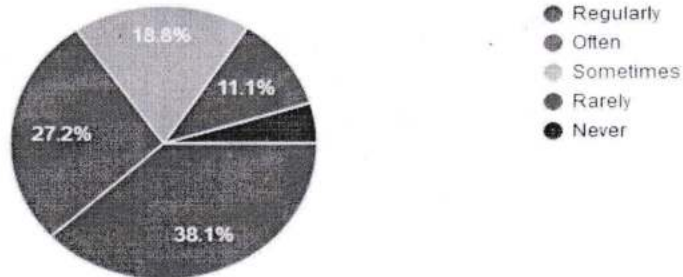

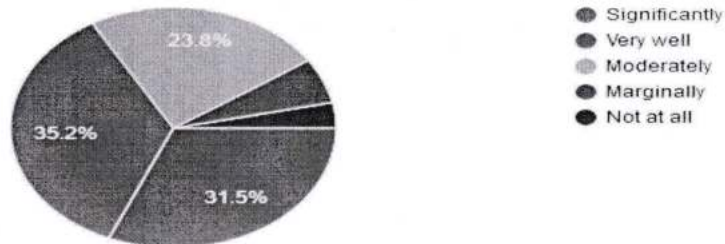

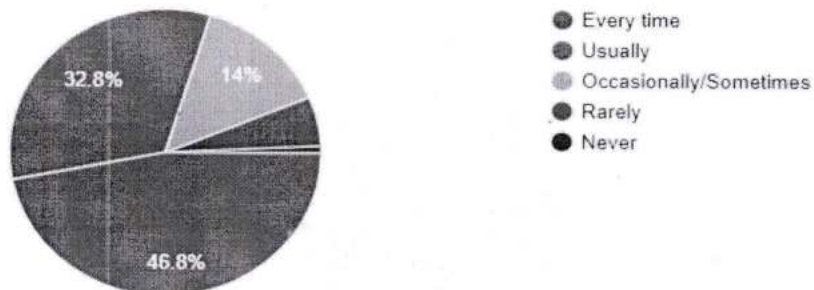

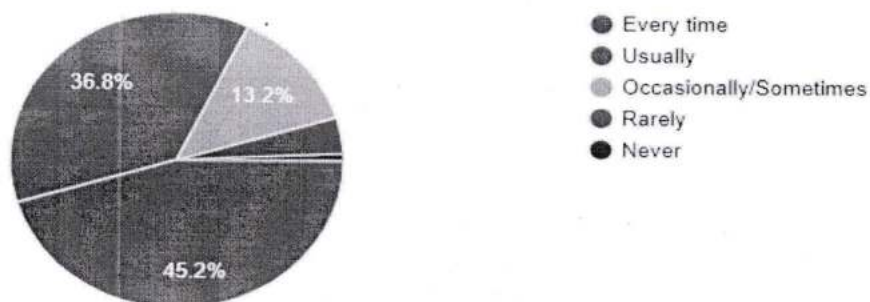

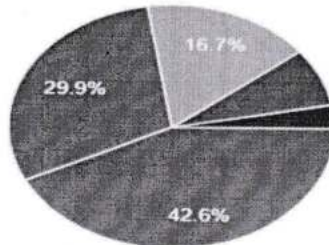

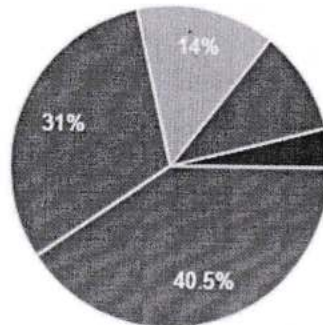

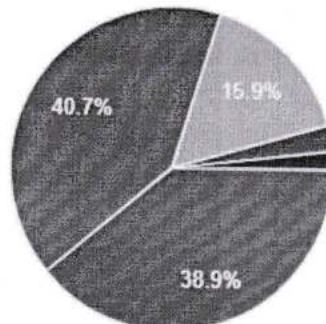

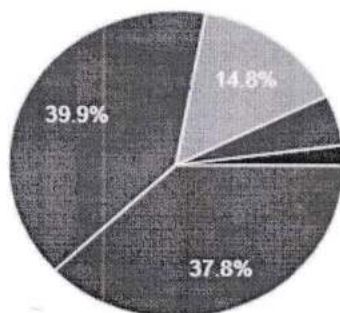

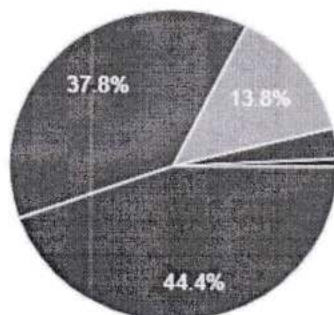

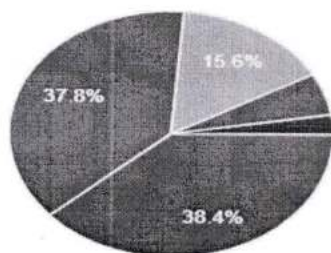

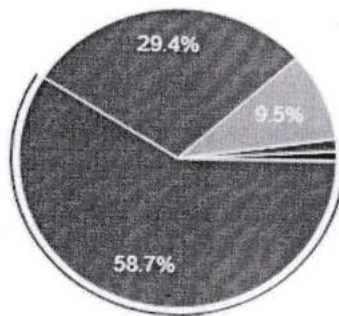




We utilize ICT tools, including LCD multimedia, to enhance the teaching and learning experience, integrating technology for effective communication of educational content

What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.

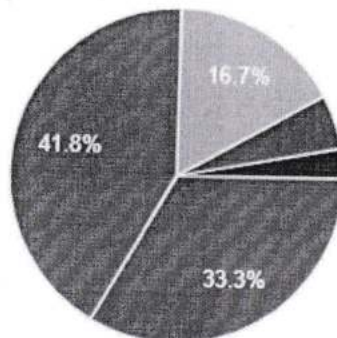

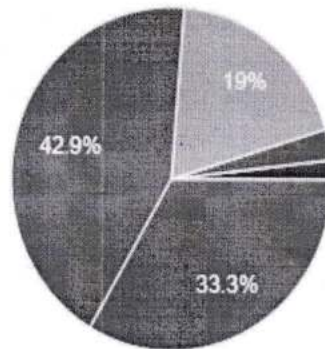
