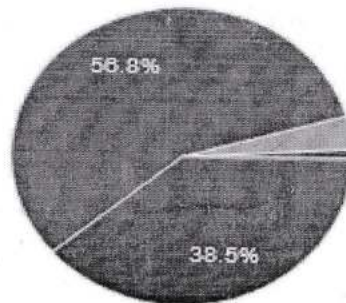


Student satisfaction Survey Report Academic Year 2021-22

How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

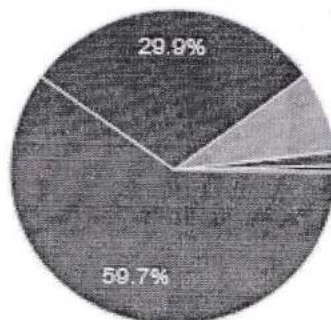

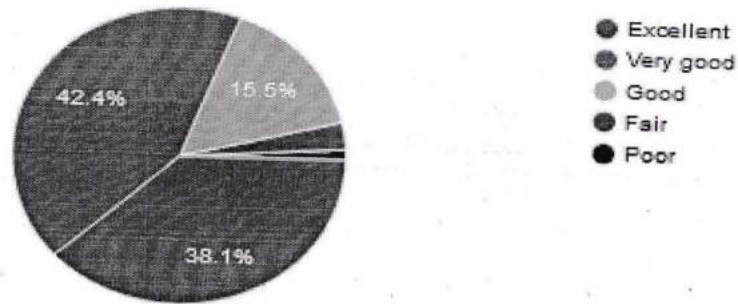

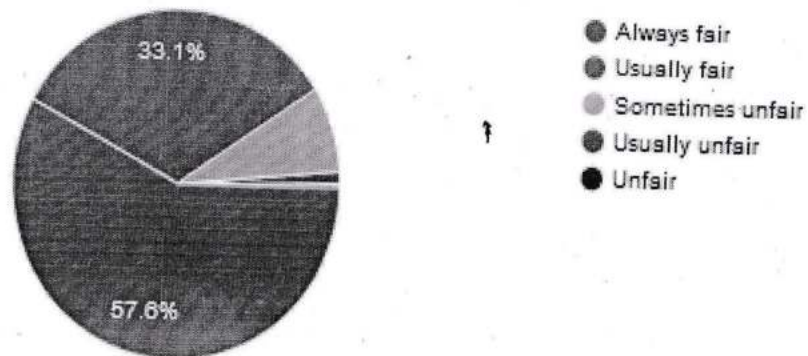
The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

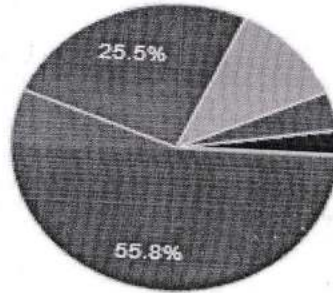
Fairness and transparency of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.

Was your performance in assignments, Projects discussed with you?

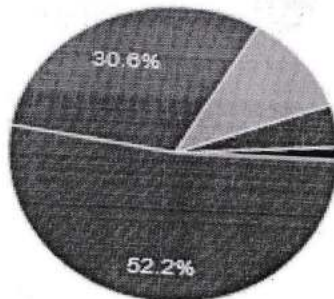

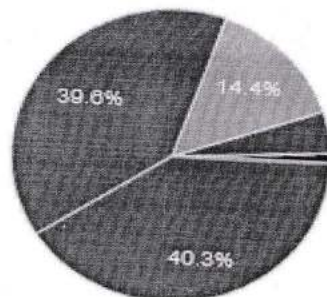

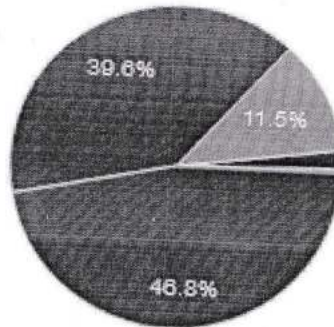

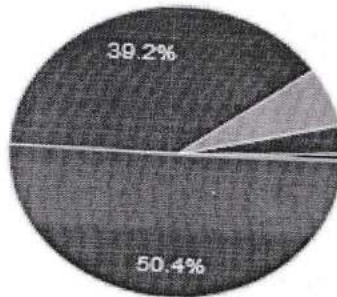

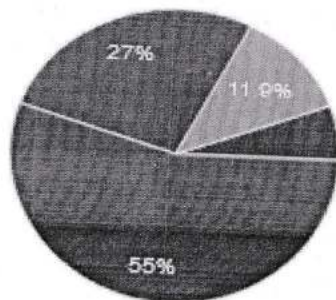

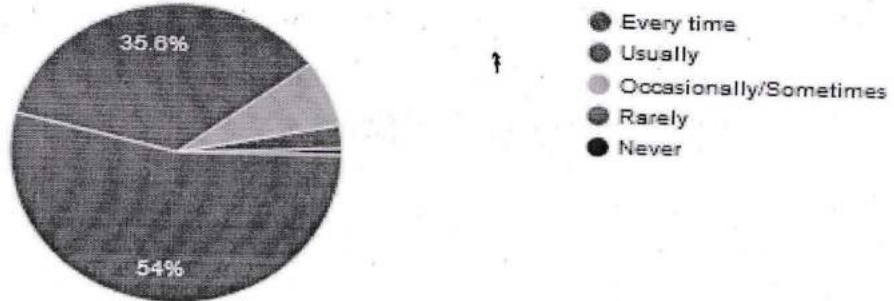

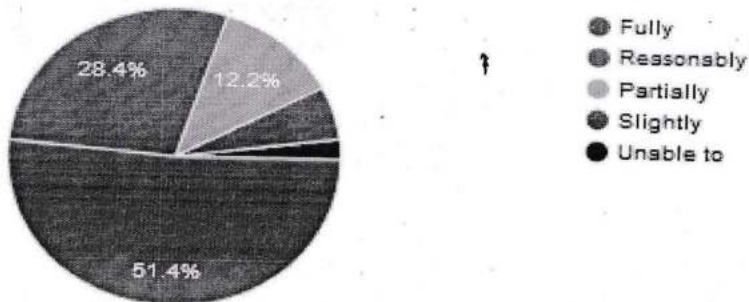
The teachers illustrate the concepts through practical, examples and applications

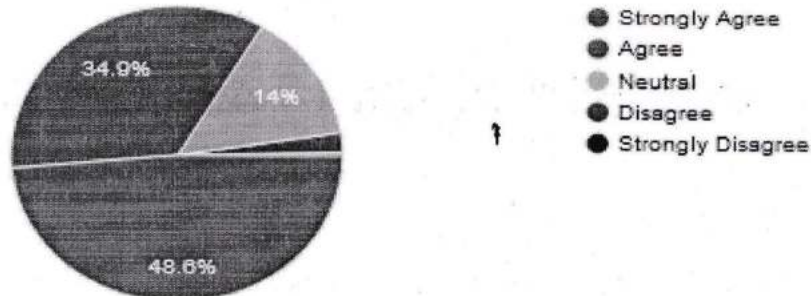

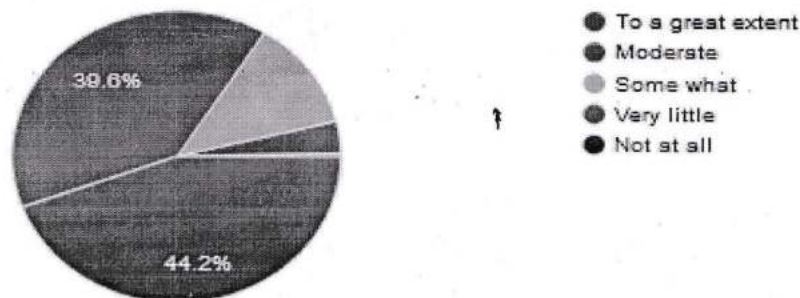

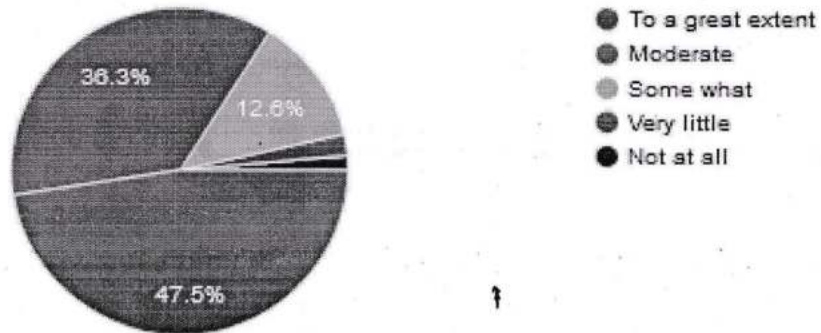

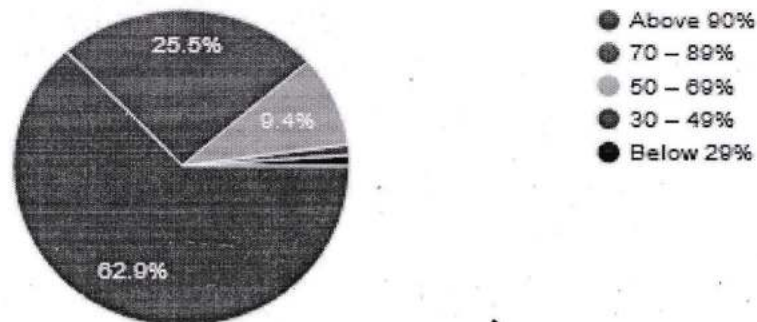

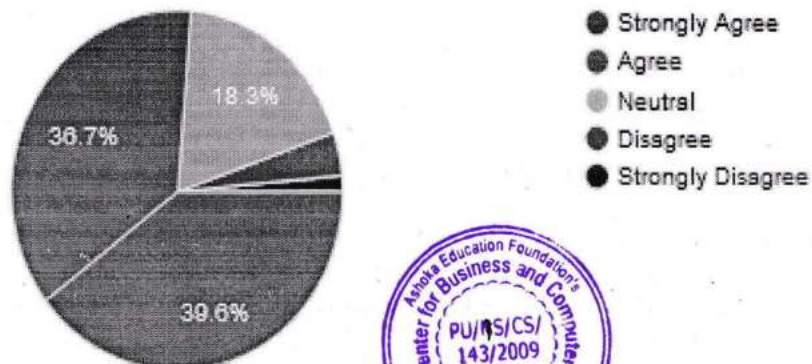
What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.

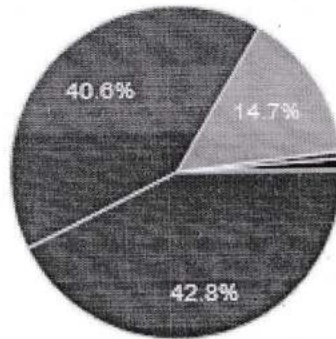
Is institute providing you the platform to showcase your hidden talent?
